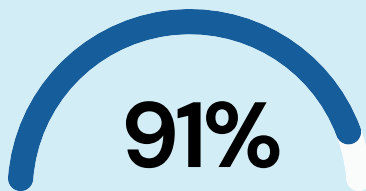
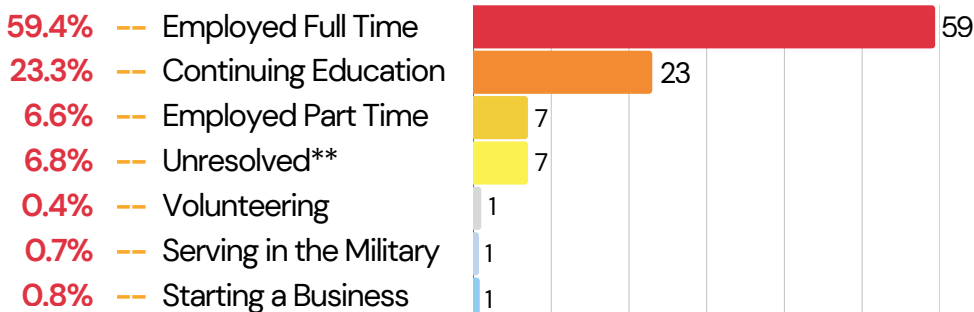

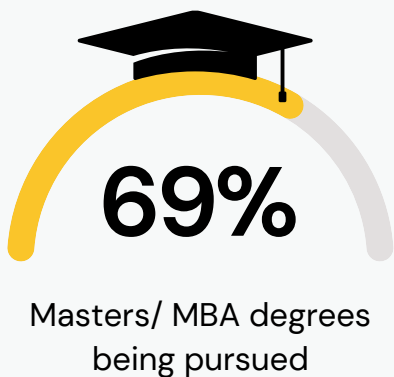


MEDIAN SALARY RANGE

Salary information was reported by 1,630 graduates entering full-time employment.

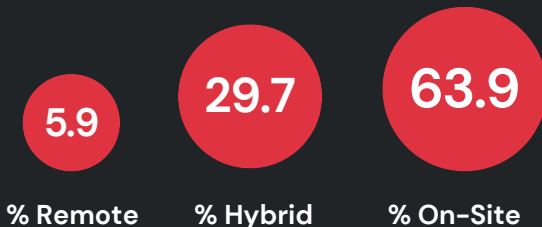

MODALITY OF WORK

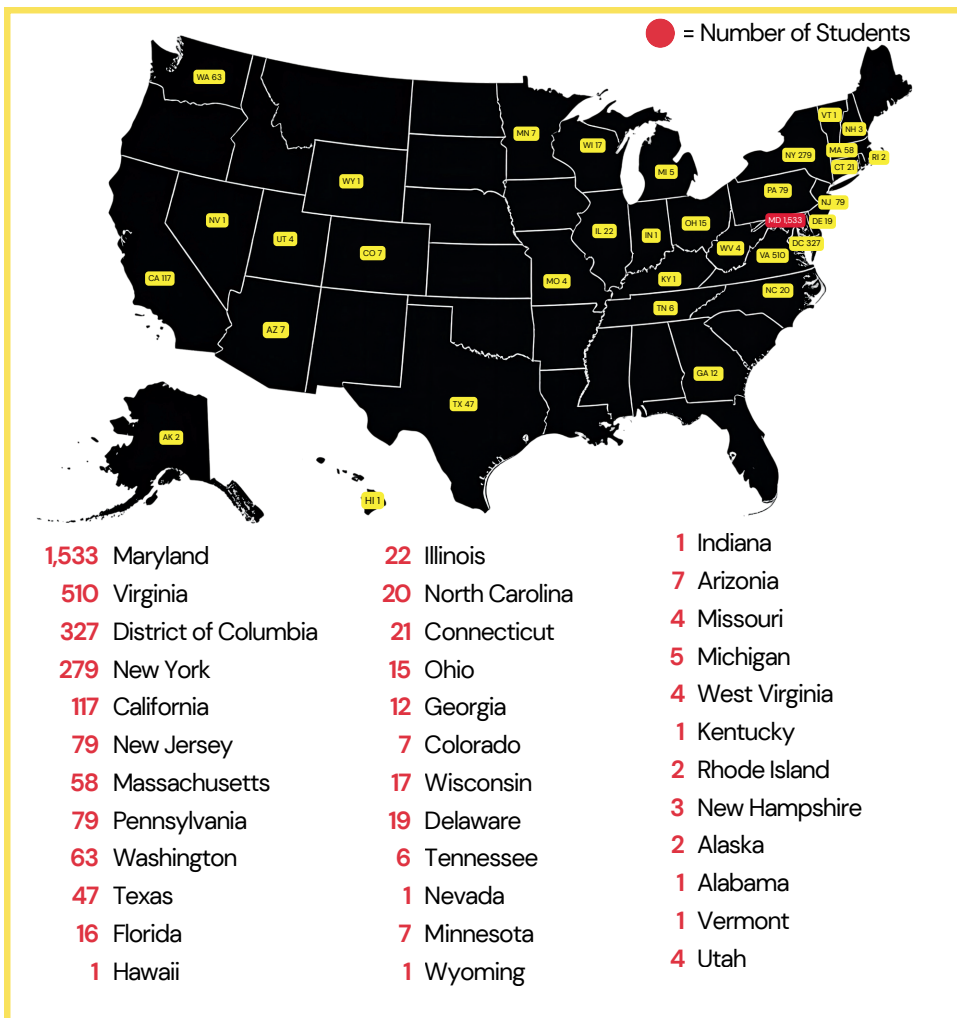
Out of 2,715 responses, most alumni were working in either a hybrid or in-person arrangement.
